100 Years Ago

The Allen Downtown Toronto theatre located on the southwest corner of Richmond and Victoria opened in 1917. It was the first theatre in Toronto to show a "talkie" picture in 1928. By 1920 the Allen theatre chain was the largest in Canada. The theatre was renamed the Tivoli and later taken over by Famous Players, it closed in 1965. The Allen family, with Brian Allen continues to operate theatres today as Premier Operating.
